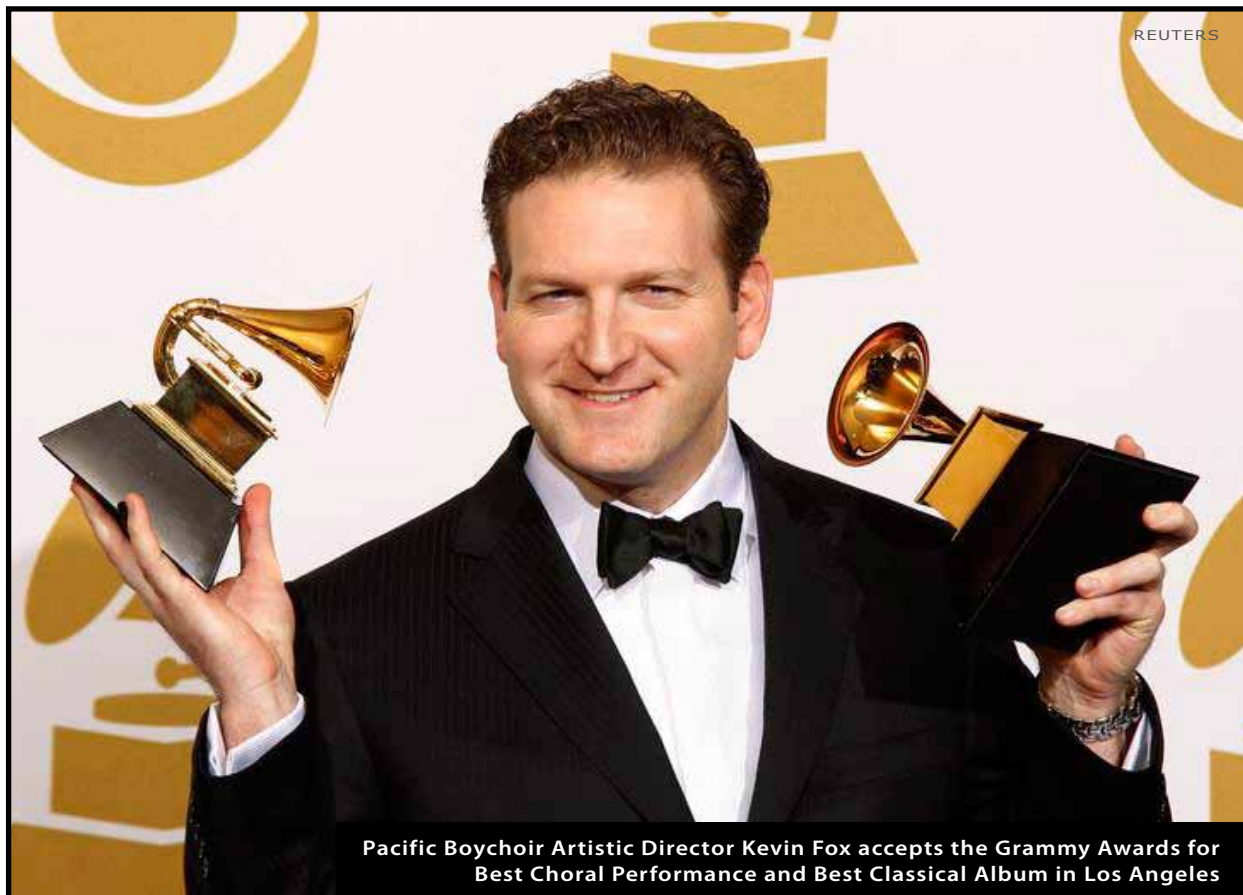

Mahler 8 sweeps nominated categories at the Grammys

At the 52nd Annual Grammy Awards on Sunday, January 31, the San Francisco Symphony's recording of Mahler's Eighth Symphony won three awards: Best Classical Engineering, Best Choral Performance, and Best Classical Album. The recording features the San Francisco Symphony, eight soloists, the San Francisco Symphony Chorus, the San Francisco Girls Chorus, and the Pacific Boychoir, all under the direction of maestro Michael Tilson Thomas.

Director Kevin Fox traveled to the Grammy Awards and was on hand to accept the awards for Best Choral Performance and Best Classical Album. "It was a real thrill to be able to represent the boys of the PBA and all the fine artists that contributed to MTT's vision for Mahler 8," said Fox. "At one point, we had more wins than Beyoncé, but then she pulled ahead."
